Minutes of the virtual meeting of the Scottish Printing Archival Trust held at 10.45am on Monday 22 February 2021.

1. Apologies

2. Minutes of the meeting held on 24 September 2020 and matters arising  
The minutes were approved and there were no matters arising.

3. Financial update  
PL circulated a financial statement for the year to 31 January 2021. There had been no significant change since then, apart from the regular payments for the website. Thanks to the support of Antalis and with GR's help the storage facility had been given up, and the stocks of books and exhibition panels were now stored at Antalis office in Livingston. Funds in the bank and PayPal accounts stand at £9,381.84.

4. Secretary's report  
HW's report had been circulated before the meeting. There was not much to report, but she had done some work to update the website. An enquiry had been received from a member of staff working with the printing collections at the City of Edinburgh Museums Service, and HW was hoping to follow this up.

5. Future strategy  
PL commented that the Trust was effectively in hibernation at the moment, but that this was the best course of action at the moment.

HW said that she would see if there were any opportunities to arrange printing walks when outdoor events were allowed again, but was waiting to see for the moment. The next publication was to be a second edition of the *Edinburgh Print Trail* leaflet, but she had suspended work on this until it was possible to hold a launch event and walks based on the leaflet.

BH asked the Trustees to consider future appointments of Trustee now that Bernulf Clegg had stepped down. PM suggested that Trustees from the Glasgow or Edinburgh Schools of Art would be appropriate.

PL said that he would enquire after the health of Harry McIntosh.
